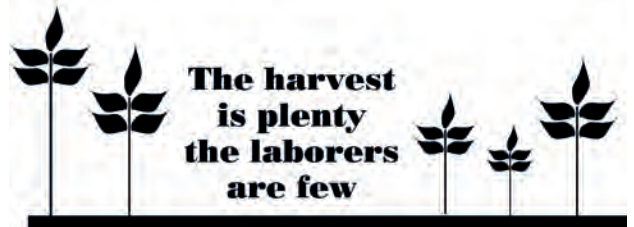

Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading: 1 Kings 3:5, 7-12

Solomon, realizing that he will succeed his father David as King of Israel and Judah, begs the Lord to give him wisdom and understanding in order to rule his people well. The Lord grants his request saying, "... there will come no one to equal you."

Second Reading: Romans 8:28-30

As heirs of God and heirs with Christ, we suffer in order to be glorified with Christ, we suffer in order to be glorified with Christ.

Gospel: Matthew 13:44-52

Jesus speaks again about the "reign of God," telling the parables of the buried treasure and the merchant's search for pearls. In each parable, Jesus emphasizes that the "reign of God" is more precious and valuable than any treasure.

MEDITATION:

"The Lord was pleased that Solomon made this request. So, God said to him: 'Because you have asked for this – not for a long life for yourself, nor for the riches, nor for the life of your enemies, but for understanding so that you may know what is right – I do as you requested. I give you a heart so wise and understanding that there has never been anyone like you up to now, and after you there will come, no one to equal you.'"

How frequently the expression, 'the wisdom of Solomon' describes someone who pauses, thinks things through, and then decides.

This Old Testament giant individual offers a model. As I approach the Lord in my prayer today, He wants to know my care and need. 'Ask something of me and I will give it to you.'

What is my response, my need, my care? How deep is my faith in the Lord that He listens or even cares? My response reflects the trust I place in my God.

'Jesus, I trust in you.' Please hear me. 'Give your servant an understanding heart.'

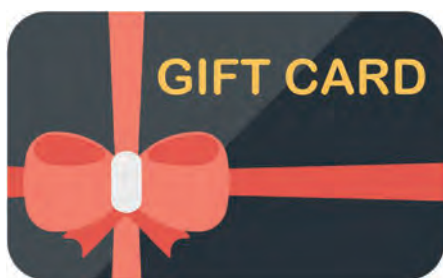

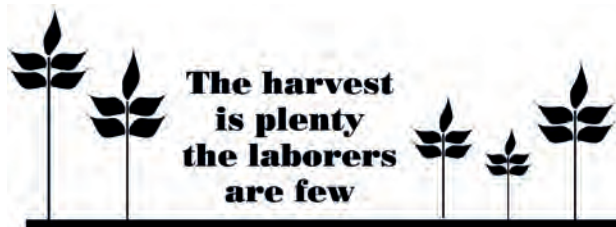

Decimoséptimo Domingo en Tiempo Ordinario

Primera lectura: 1 Reyes 3:5, 7-12

Salomón, dándose cuenta de que sucederá a su padre David como rey de Israel y Judá, suplica al Señor que le dé sabiduría y entendimiento para gobernar bien a su pueblo. El Señor concede su petición diciendo: "... No vendrá nadie que te iguale."

Segunda lectura: Romanos 8:28-30

Como herederos de Dios y herederos con Cristo, sufrimos para ser glorificados con Cristo, sufrimos para ser glorificados con Cristo.

Evangelio: Mateo 13:44-52

Jesús vuelve a hablar sobre el "reinado de Dios", contando las parábolas del tesoro enterrado y la búsqueda de perlas por parte del mercader. En cada parábola, Jesús enfatiza que el "reinado de Dios" es más valioso y valioso que cualquier tesoro.

MEDITACIÓN:

"El Señor se alegró de que Salomón hiciera esta petición. Así que Dios le dijo: 'Porque has pedido esto – no una larga vida para ti, ni para las riquezas, ni para la vida de tus enemigos, sino para que sepas lo que es correcto – hago lo que me pediste. Te doy un corazón tan sabio y comprensivo que nunca ha habido nadie como tú hasta ahora, y después de ti vendrá, nadie te igualará.'"

Con qué frecuencia la expresión 'la sabiduría de Salomón' describe a alguien que se detiene, reflexiona y luego decide.

Este gigante del Antiguo Testamento ofrece un modelo. Al acercarme al Señor en mi oración hoy, Él quiere conocer mi cuidado y mi necesidad. 'Pídemelo algo y te lo daré.'

¿Cuál es mi respuesta, mi necesidad, mi cuidado? ¿Qué tan profunda es mi fe en el Señor para que Él escuche o incluso le importe? Mi respuesta refleja la confianza que deposito en mi Dios.

'Jesús, confío en ti.' Por favor, escúchame. 'Dale a tu sirviente un corazón comprensivo.'

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
