Pastor's Reflection

Kwanzaa, (December 26 - January 1st) is the Harvest festival celebrated at this time out of various African Cultures.

All are welcome – whether you're new to Scripture or a seasoned Bible reader, this study is for you!

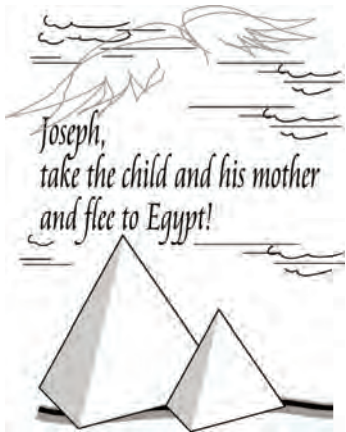

FIRST READING: Sirach 3:2-6, 12-14

This passage from Sirach details the duties children owe to father and mother. Their life-long devotion will not be forgotten and “will take lasting root.”

SECOND READING: Colossians 3:12-21

Paul urges Christians particularly in the setting of the family, to “clothe” themselves with kindness, patience, humility, and mercy; to forgive; and, above all, to love!

GOSPEL: Matthew 2:13-15, 19-23

An angel of the Lord, appearing in a dream to Joseph, urges him to flee with Jesus and Mary to Egypt to escape the murderous schemes of Herod. Later, in another dream, an angel tells Joseph to go with Jesus and Mary to a town called Nazareth in the region of Galilee, thus fulfilling the Scriptures: “He shall be called a Nazarene.”

MEDITATION

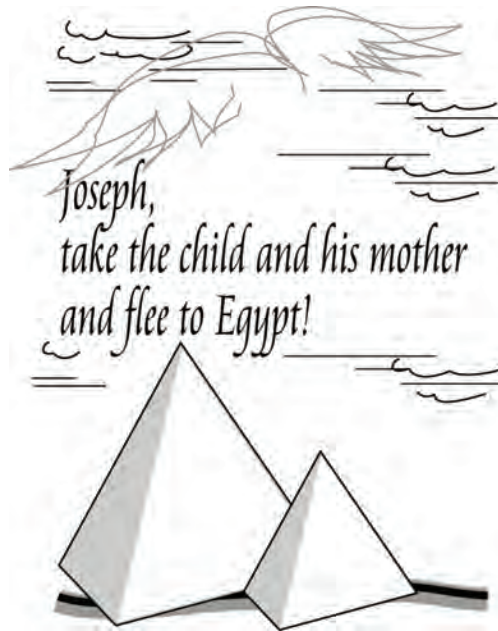
La solemnidad de María, Madre de Dios

**PRIMERA LECTURA: Sirac 3:2-6, 12-14**

Este pasaje de Sirach detalla los deberes que los hijos deben al padre y a la madre. Su devoción de por vida no será olvidada y "echará raíces duraderas."

SEGUNDA LECTURA: Colosenses 3:12-21

Pablo insta a los cristianos, especialmente en el entorno familiar, a "vestirse" con bondad, paciencia, humildad y misericordia; perdonar y, sobre todo, amar.

EVANGELIO: Mateo 2:13-15, 19-23

Un ángel del Señor, apareciendo en un sueño a José, le insta a huir con Jesús y María a Egipto para escapar de los planes asesinas de Herodes. Más tarde, en otro sueño, un ángel le dice a José que vaya con Jesús y María a una ciudad llamada Nazaret, en la región de Galilea, cumpliendo así las Escrituras: «Se le llamará nazareno».
