Pastor's Reflection

Last Friday I attended the second day of The Summit for Civil Rights held at Seton Hall University. I was surprised and pleased when I walked into the conference room. A presenter was speaking about the election of Pope Leo XVI. It was unexpected that among this mix of different religions, union representatives, New Jersey politicians and people of faith from around the State, that a Pope would be the topic of conversation. Indeed, there was great hope among those gathered that this American Pope who chose the name Leo XVI - bringing to mind Pope Leo the XIII -a supporter of workers, their rights, unions and Catholic Social Justice- would be a prophetic voice for our times. Our Lady, who was married to Joseph the Worker, was supported by the fishermen who followed her son, himself a man who worked with his hands. Gubernatorial candidates at the Summit received the opportunity to comment on the Tripartite Principles advocated by the Summit. I listened to three who made agreeable noises. They were: Stephen Sweeney, former Senate President; Ras Baraka Mayor of Newark; Sean Spiller and Mayor Steve Fulop of Jersey City. There was a Republican candidate who responded on the first night of the Summit. The Tripartite Principles of the Summit are jobs, housing and school policy. Online, information about the summit and the principles can be found. Bishop Manuel A. Cruz of the Archdiocese of Newark, gave greetings from Cardinale Tobin who, for obvious reasons, was not present as he was electing a Pope in Rome. Bishop Cruz shared his family's immigrant story from Cuba and the importance of unions, worker's rights and Catholic Social Justice to the proclamation of the Gospel. I end this reflection with a quote from Rerum Novarum. " the rich must religiously refrain from cutting down the workmen's earnings, whether by force, by fraud, or by usurious dealing;... " .

Reflexión del Pastor

El viernes pasado asistí al segundo día de la Cumbre por los Derechos Civiles celebrada en la Universidad de Seton Hall. Me quedé sorprendido y complacido cuando entré en la sala de conferencias. Un presentador estaba hablando sobre la elección del Papa León XVI. Fue inesperado que entre esta mezcla de diferentes religiones, representantes sindicales, políticos de Nueva Jersey y personas de fe de todo el estado, un Papa fuera el tema de conversación. De hecho, había una gran esperanza entre los reunidos de que este Papa estadounidense que eligió el nombre de León XVI -recordando al Papa León XIII -un defensor de los trabajadores, sus derechos, los sindicatos y la justicia social católica- sería una voz profética para nuestro tiempo. Nuestra Señora, que estaba casada con José el Obrero, era sostenida por los pescadores que seguían a su hijo, que también era un hombre que trabajaba con sus manos. Los candidatos a gobernadores en la Cumbre tuvieron la oportunidad de formular observaciones sobre los Principios Tripartitos propugnados por la Cumbre. Escuché a tres que hacían ruidos agradables. Ellos fueron: Stephen Sweeney, expresidente del Senado; Ras Baraka, alcalde de Newark; Sean Spiller y el alcalde Steve Fulop de Jersey City. Hubo un candidato republicano que respondió en la primera noche de la Cumbre. Los Principios Tripartitos de la Cumbre son el empleo, la vivienda y la política escolar. En línea, se puede encontrar información sobre la cumbre y los principios. El Obispo Manuel A. Cruz, de la Arquidiócesis de Newark, saludó al Cardenal Tobin quien, por razones obvias, no estaba presente ya que estaba eligiendo a un Papa en Roma. El Obispo Cruz compartió la historia de su familia como inmigrante de Cuba y la importancia de los sindicatos, los derechos de los trabajadores y la justicia social católica para la proclamación del Evangelio. Terminó esta reflexión con una cita de la Rerum Novarum. "Los ricos deben abstenerse religiosamente de recortar las ganancias de los obreros, ya sea por la fuerza, por el fraude o por el trato usurario; " .
