Pastor Reflection

CHRIST IS RISEN!

Today at St. Nicholas Historic Church, Father Joseph Esser will be remembered with a small prayer service after the 8:30am. mass. I am informed by Mr. Joe Picardi that Father Esser "died April 27, 1885, at the age of 33. " He died from a fall from his carriage near 6th Terrace and Beethoven Streets. This year marks the 139th anniversary of his death.

There is a memorial of Father Esser on the left side of St. Nicholas Church; Father's remains lie under the church basement. This year and next we mark celebrations for the founding of both St. Nicholas and Assumption Parishes.

St. Nicholas is one hundred-sixty years, praise God! Next year will be one hundred years for Assumption, praise God!

Ideas to celebrate the former parishes - now Our Lady of Perpetual Help Parish- are being considered. Donna Marie Berchtold and Joe Picardi can be contacted with any ideas that you may have. There is a need for ideas and volunteers for Assumption (Parish) and school. The Diocese has engaged a company in an initiative, "Called for More." This will be "a two-year revitalization process using data and analysis of ministry to • provide Church leaders with focus and courage to engage the culture with an apostolic mindset, • creating a space for priests to recall and live into the joy of their ministry and • highlighting mission and evangelization needs for parishes to pursue.

Transforms assignment process supported by gathering data and benchmarking. • Creates experience for priests of ongoing personal and leadership growth and development regardless of age or assignment. • Provides a resource to parishes that supports their unique role as a community of faith. • Supports diocese in improving its care of priests and parishes, especially with transitions."

Could be a good thing marking the two anniversaries of our parish. All parishioners online will have the opportunity to provide data. For now, I am praying for a **PPC -Primary Point of Contact** person who will assist with the data input and communications between the Called for More team, myself and parishioners. Fun Stuff!

Also, we are engaged in our **South Jersey Catholic Mission Appeal**. I am encouraged by the many of you who have already generously responded. It is by these initiatives that we intend to sustain the mission and ministry, begun by such persons as Fr. Esser over 139 years ago, dynamic into the next hundred years for the glory of God and the salvation of God's people.
