Since my mom and grandmom died the food of Thanksgiving has not been the same. As my remaining brothers and sister live in Nevada and travel is hell, Thanksgiving has not been a gathering of family for a long time. In the past I have shared Thanksgiving with the homeless at the soup-kitchens of Camden. On some occasions I have accepted the invitations of friends and parishioners to join with them. I am grateful for this, but do not often accept. Many people find themselves in similar situations for the holidays. Many of us reach a time in our lives when we cannot celebrate as we once did: health, separation, deaths, travel and loss of interest can change our holiday celebrations. I find myself year by year separating from the World's celebration of the holidays and moving closer to a more Kingdom of Heaven celebration. Halloween to All souls, Thanksgiving to the Eucharist. Christmas to the Incarnation. As our nation becomes more secular and more "Christians" disdain "organize religion" I find their celebrations to be celebrations of nothing and death.

This year, this time of Revelation when Ron Regan is "not afraid of burning in hell", invites Catholics to give an account of our faith: Holidays vs. Holy Days!
