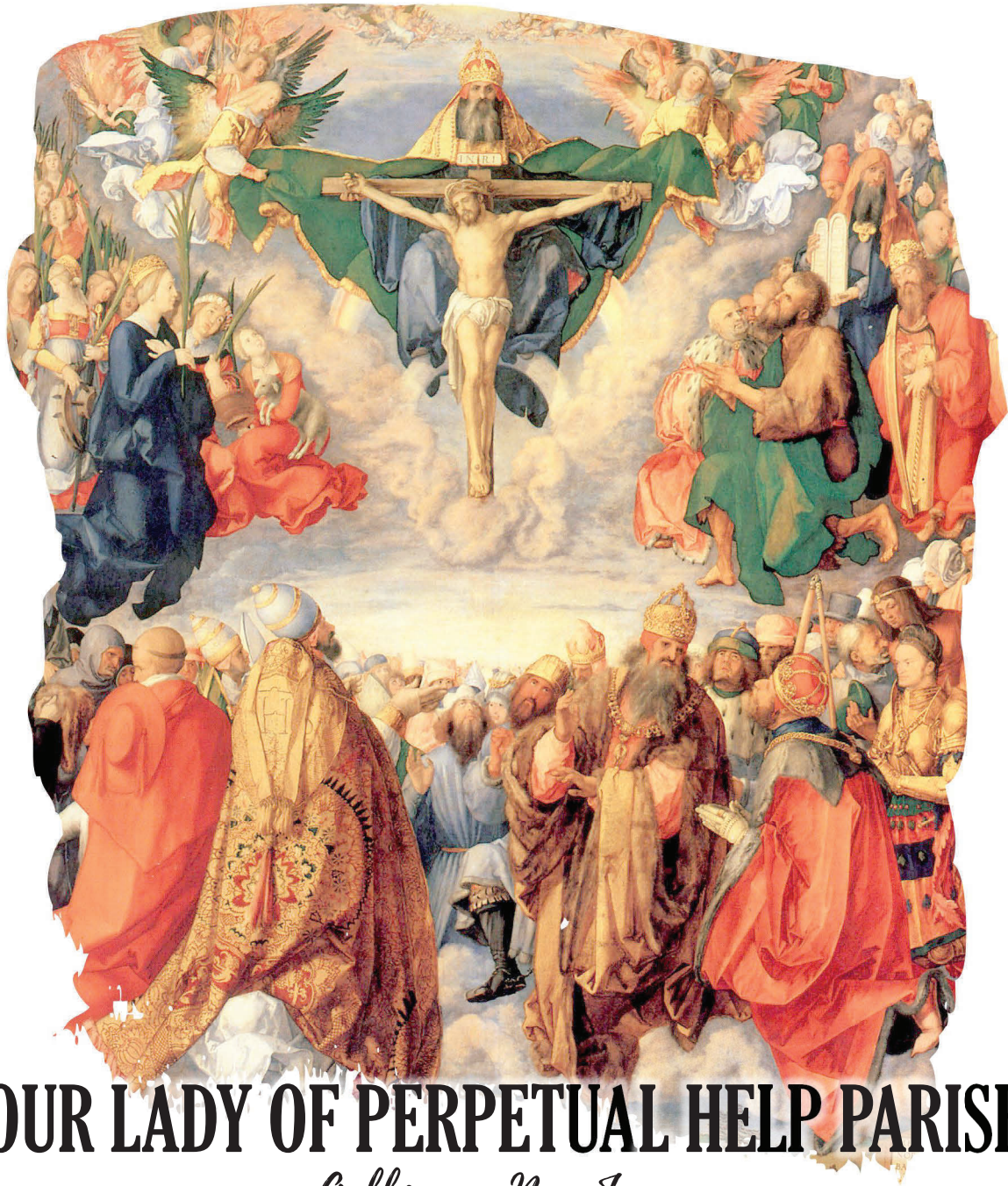

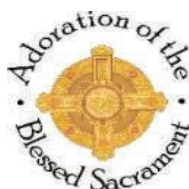

Pastor's Reflection

Since October is Right to Life Month, I have been praying my rosary for a "more perfect union", the establishment of justice and promotion of the general welfare of We the People.

I am discerning how an Advent Bible study might address my prayer. I recently received a book entitled, "The Politics of Jesus" by John Howard Yoder, 1994 and I am also reading Howard Thurman's classic, "Jesus and the Disinherited", first published in 1949. Both books address the question of what the religion of Jesus has to say to people living with their backs against the wall. Jesus was God's response to the Hebrew people living under the heel of the Roman Empire and sin. Is he also God's answer for us today?

Next month New Jersians will vote, and the nation will be watching. Each vote and non-vote will reveal something about our faith in Jesus Christ. In each of the ten Eucharistic prayers we pray for the mystical union of the people of God, "...filled with his Holy Spirit, may [we] become one body, one spirit in Christ." The darkness that has descended upon us and from us is of that evil that seeks to destroy the "one body, one spirit in Christ." How shall we meet the challenge by which we are revealed as a light in the darkness? I want to study the Gospel of St. Matthew this Advent for insight, method, and power to testify as Disciples of Jesus in this time of the anti-Christ. Matthew 24:24, "For false Christs shall arise, and false prophets, and will do wonderful miracles so that if it were possible, even God's chosen ones would be deceived. See, I have warned you."

Extraordinary Minister Ministry

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion aid the priest or deacon on the altar with the distribution of communion. This is done so the Eucharist can be distributed to all at mass in a dignified and reverent manner. It is a ministry of bringing the sacrament of the Body and Blood of Christ to the people of God. Those in this ministry receive spiritual, theological and practical preparation to fulfill their role with knowledge and reverence.

Members of this ministry must be baptized and confirmed Catholics, parishioners of OLPH Parish, be at least 15 years old, and have taken a training course through the Diocese of Camden. Once one has been called to this ministry and affirmed by the pastor, they may take part in the training course. Training sessions will be announced to the parish as they come available.

Eucharistic Ministers may choose to serve at mass or bring communion to those infirmed in nursing homes or in their homes. For those who serve at mass, the point of contact is **Terry Bell, 609-504-3505, tabellmd@comcast.net.**

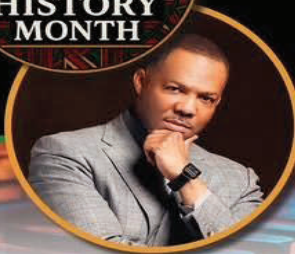

Reflexión del Pastor

Dado que octubre es el Mes del Derecho a la Vida, he estado rezando mi rosario por una "unión más perfecta", el establecimiento de la justicia y la promoción del bienestar general de Nosotros, el Pueblo.

Estoy discerniendo cómo un estudio bíblico de Adviento podría abordar mi oración. Recientemente recibí un libro titulado "La política de Jesús" de John Howard Yoder, 1994 y también estoy leyendo el clásico de Howard Thurman, "Jesús y los desheredados", publicado por primera vez en 1949. Ambos libros abordan la cuestión de lo que la religión de Jesús tiene que decir a las personas que viven con la espalda contra la pared. Jesús fue la respuesta de Dios al pueblo hebreo que vivía bajo el talón del Imperio Romano y el pecado. ¿Es también la respuesta de Dios para nosotros hoy?

El próximo mes, los habitantes de New Jersians votarán y la nación estará observando. Cada voto y no voto revelará algo acerca de nuestra fe en Jesucristo. En cada una de las diez plegarias eucarísticas rezamos por la unión mística del pueblo de Dios, "... Llenos de su Espíritu Santo, que [nosotros] seamos un solo cuerpo, un solo espíritu en Cristo". La oscuridad que ha descendido sobre nosotros y de nosotros es de ese mal que busca destruir el "un cuerpo, un espíritu en Cristo". ¿Cómo enfrentaremos el desafío por el cual somos revelados como una luz en la oscuridad? Quiero estudiar el Evangelio de San Mateo en este Adviento en busca de conocimiento, método y poder para testificar como discípulos de Jesús en este tiempo del anticristo. Mateo 24:24, "Porque se levantarán falsos Cristos y falsos profetas, y harán milagros maravillosos, de modo que, si fuera posible, aun los escogidos de Dios serían engañados. Mira, te lo he advertido".

Poder para el Pueblo de Dios.

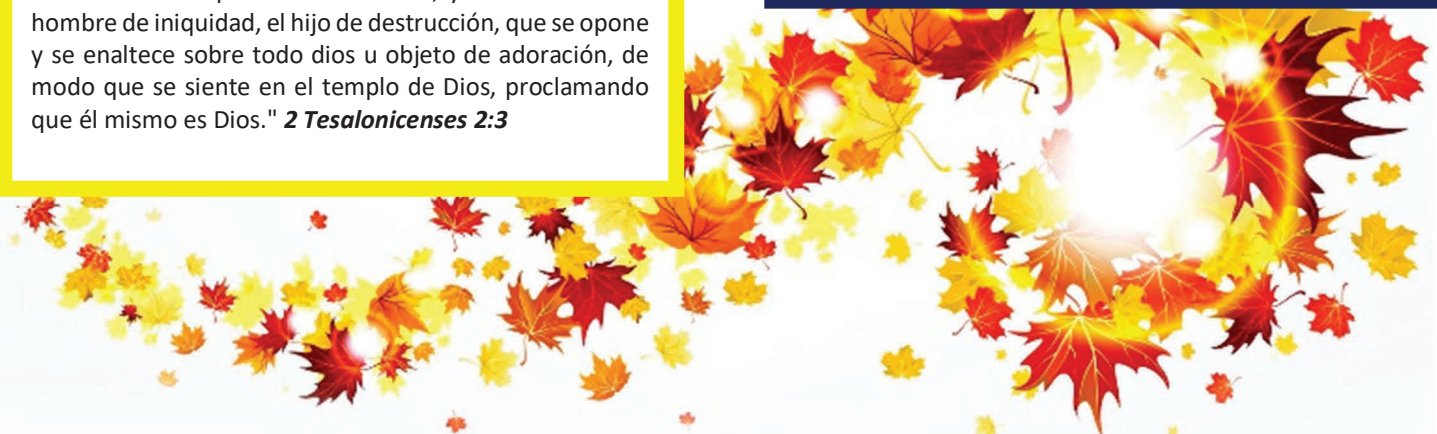
