Pastor's Reflection

February 27th my doctor diagnosed: "You are officially diabetic." I received this not-good news, well enough. "Life is changed not ended." Now it is about percentage points. The task for me is for those percentages to not grow larger in the direction of illness and death, Praise God!

On Friday the last day of February, I experienced a cold bath of humiliation and guilt when I saw and heard my government's treatment of the Ukrainian people and president. I feel the dread and disorientation that can accompany truth -the ugly truth cavorting in all its shameless, self-centered wickedness-about oneself, one's nation. I confess that I am a sinner; that I miss the mark of the glory and image of the God who is Love so.....Grace and Mercy! Such a 'miss' unmanaged, can lead to soul sickness and death -diabetes of the spirit. Too much sweetness. Too much hubris.

Lent is a season that helps with the management of too much sweetness, too much hubris. We humble ourselves by confessing the naked truth about ourselves -ugly though it may sometimes be. We serve others. We accept the hospitality of Grace and Mercy. We abstain from sweet and prideful things and in eschatological hope of the Resurrection, we die to self.
